Clear Cache

- 1. On your computer, open Chrome.
- 2. At the top right, click on the three dots in the top right corner
- 3. Scroll down to 'More Tools'

- 6. At the top, change the default Time range from 'Last hour' to 'All time'.
- 7. All three options should have a check mark ("Browsing history', Cookies and other site data' and 'Cached images and files')
