About

Wireless Internet access is available for personal devices everywhere on campus. At SLC, we have two WiFi networks on campus. The 'eduroam' network is a secure network that you can access with the same username and password used to sign in to slc.me or college computers and will replace SLCConnect. The 'SLC' network is a secure network for corporate managed devices only. These devices automatically connect to this network.

How to Connect:

Personal Computer/Laptop

To connect your personal computer/laptop you must **select a wireless network** that your device can connect to. Click on the **connection/Wi-Fi icon** to view available network options.



A list of available networks will pop up. Click eduroam.



Windows

Connect to eduroam using your SLC account to sign in. When you select this network, you will be presented with the screen below. You will type in your full college email address (typically first.last@sl.on.ca) for the **username** and your **password** used to sign in to slc.me or college computers. Click **Ok** or **Join** to connect.

Android

To connect your Android phone or tablet to Wi-Fi, please follow the steps below:

Swipe down from the top of the phone, then long tap on the Wi-Fi or Internet icon.



From the Wi-Fi settings menu, select **eduroam**.





You will be required to sign into the network with your SLC login credentials. In the **Username** or **Identity** field enter your full college email address, and your **Password** in the password field. The same password is used when signing into slc.me or college computers. If your version of Android requires, you may need to type *sl.on.ca* in the **Domain** field. For the **CA certificate** or **Online Certificate** dropdown menu tap **Trust on First Use**. Tap **Connect**.
