COURSE DESCRIPTION:

ESTH 43 – MAKE-UP (60 hours)

This course teaches students the theory and practical for makeup application. Topics include: definitions, morphology, facial shapes and balance, color classifications, observations and factors to consider prior to make-up application, proper steps and techniques involved in makeup application, supplies brushes and products used. Students will also be taught to create a variety of make-up styles suitable for day, evening, bridal and special events.
