Music Theatre - Performance Fee	B (Program Specific) ³	Sem 1,2,3,4 \$650/semester \$1300 max/year Sem 5 & 6 \$975/semester \$1950 max/year	Provides students in Music Theatre Performance Program with private (one on one) lessons with qualified vocal teachers and repertoire coaches.
Paramedic Fee	C (Program Specific) ⁴	\$10 Semester 1 \$303 Semester 3 \$365 Semester 4	For students in the Paramedic program, facilitates learning in labs and practice time, and covers costs of protective equipment which is required by hospitals and EMS services allowing students to participate in field placements.
Technology Programs Fee	C (Program Specific) ⁵	\$75/semester \$150 max/year	Provides a number of technology-focused enhanced services/equipment.
Trades Fee	C (Program Specific) ⁶	\$10/semester \$20 max/year	Used to recoup expenses incurred by the College for students' personal take home projects – such as nails, glue, electrodes in welding shop, supplies used on students' personal vehicles in the auto shop, etc.
Computer Programs Technology Fee	K (Program Specific) ⁷	\$30/semester \$60 max/year	Used to enhance Educational Information Technologies (EIT) in the Information System Computer Lab, and direct academic enhancement
Culinary Program – Food Safe Handler's Certificate Fee	K (Program Specific) ⁸	\$25/first semester	Covers cost of 1 st year students to take the Food Safe Handler's Certification through KFLA (Kingston, Frontenac and Lennox & Addington Public Health).
Graphic Design Membership Fee	K (Program Specific) ⁹	\$12.50/semester \$25 max/year	Graphic Design Program student fees for membership in the Registered Graphic Designers of Ontario. Entitles students to compete for ten \$1,000 scholarships and includes additional benefits.
Hairstyling Program Fee	K (Program Specific) ¹⁰	\$1200.00/ 1st semester	General equipment fees; Provides students in Hairstyling program with hair dressing equipment kit required as learning material.
Hospitality Fee (Formerly the Hotel & Restaurant Fee)	K (Program Specific) ¹¹	\$11/per semester	This program fee covers Smart Serve Certification (Alcohol service) and a safety certification from the Health Unit for students in the Hospitality program.
Music and Digital Media Applied Lesson Fee	K (Program Specific) ¹²	\$650/per semester	Covers mandatory applied music lessons which occur once per week throughout every semester of the program and the juried assessment that happens as a culminating event for these lessons at the end of second and fourth semester for students in the Music and Digital Media program.

Culinary Program Fee	K (Program Specific) ¹⁴	\$250.00	The fee covers palate development as part of the practical lab evaluation process. Students are encouraged to sample and take home some of their finished products.
Canadian Nursing Student Association Fee	T (Program Specific) ¹⁵	\$15/1st semester	Allows students to attend the Canadian Nursing Association (CNSA) annual conference and to pay for membership dues.
Non-violent Crisis Intervention training Materials BScN and PN (B&K) Programs only	T (Program Specific) ¹⁶	\$39.25/1st semester (PN & BScN) \$24/5th semester (BScN only)	NVCI training is mandatory training for all nursing students (PN and BScN) tri-campus prior to attending clinical placement. Mandatory course for program- cost covers book.
Registered Nurses' Association of Ontario Fee	T (Program Specific) ¹⁷	\$16/1st semester/year	Provides students with membership for the Registered Nurses' Association of Ontario (RNAO). Includes membership into Nursing Student of Ontario (NSO), which represents and acts as a resource for students.
