Compulsory Ancillary Fee	Amount	Description
Academic Tutoring and Supports	\$28/semester	Tutoring services, including one-on-one professional tutoring, peer tutoring, group tutoring, and supplemental instructions, and various workshops are available to help students build skills for success. These support services are included in the Ministry's guidelines as a compulsory fee College can charge to provide the essential services.
Alumni Fee	\$10/semester	Provides support for the College's alumni operations which includes programs and services to each of our students, for a lifetime upon graduation.
Career Services	\$18/semester	Provide Career Services on all three campuses.
Emergency Relief Fund	\$2.55/semester	Provides support to students in emergency need and covers support for student led initiatives.
Health Centre Fee	\$18/semester	Provides primary care services including Physiotherapy, Immunizations, Birth control and Health education services.
Information Technology Fee	\$70/semester	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Network Enhancements – increase speed and access on external and internal networks including high density wifi across all three campus • Productivity Enhancements – improve services and access to productivity tools such as Office365, Adobe and slc.me • Security Enhancements – support enhanced cyber security threat protection tools such as next generation firewalls and end-point protection • Print Services – Provide a starting print quota of \$20 for each full-time student
International Health Insurance*	\$820.33/Fall start \$546.89/Winter start \$273.44/Spring start	Supports all full-time international students with Health insurance while an SLC student in Canada.
Kingston Student Association	\$3.60/semester	The Student Association fee covers the expenses related to the overall administration of Student Association services and resources.
Official Document Fee	\$10/semester	Provides students with unlimited access to the following official documents Verification of Enrollment, Unofficial Transcript and Official Transcript.

Orientation	\$15/first semester of each program start	Orientation for students to academic support services (Student Success Facilitators, Counsellors), student services broadly and college community engagement opportunities designed to support student success.
Student Achievement and Convocation Fee	\$40/initial semester of program	Covers all convocation related activities, including, but not limited to, convocation ceremonies and credential production.
Student Dental Plan*	\$88.13	The purpose of the Student Dental Plan is to support all full-time domestic students of the College by providing enhanced dental coverage
Student Health Insurance*	\$133.08/Fall start \$88.72/Winter start \$44.36/Spring start	The purpose of the Student Health Plan is to support all full-time domestic students of the College by providing enhanced coverage to supplement any universal government insurance.
Student ID Card	\$10/year	Identifies students and provides access to the library, student fitness centre, residence, labs, testing services, etc. In addition, students can pre-purchase meal plans. Students on the Kingston campus use the ID card to access the Kingston Transit System.
Student Life and Innovation Centre Sustainability Fee	\$7.50/semester	This fee supports the Student Association contribution towards capital costs of the Student Life and Innovation Centre related to sustainability.
Student Vision Plan*	\$24.88/Fall start \$16.59/Winter start \$8.29/Spring start	The purpose of the Student Vision Plan is to support all full-time domestic students of the College by providing enhanced vision coverage
Student Wellness and Success Services	\$37.50/semester	The fee supports: Counselling Services · Mental Health Counselling Services
Transition to Post Secondary Events	\$2.50/semester 1	Includes programming that allows students to connect with academic support staff (i.e. Student Success Facilitators, Tutors, Counsellors, etc. Includes Smart Start @SLC, SLC Night Against Procrastination, and more throughout the year
Workshops & Pop-up Events	\$2.50/semester	Financial Literacy, Success Workshops, Drop-In Events, etc.
