INFORMATION ABOUT THE MANDATORY RESIDENCE MEAL PLAN

Kingston Campus



- A mandatory amount of \$2100.00 will be collected by the residence when you pay your residence fees. An amount of \$950+ \$100 Flex will be allocated per semester. It includes the 13% Harmonized Sales Tax.
- The higher tier \$2,400 (\$1100 + \$100 Flex per semester) meal plan meets the Canada Revenue Agency criteria for tax free meal plans and therefore HST is not charged. This means the \$1100.00 meal plan provides a food value of the full \$1100.00.
- Once fees are received at the residence the money will be sent to Food Services to be put on a meal plan account (your student card).
- **OSAP deferrals will not have any money on your account until the residence fees are paid and received in full.**
- The meal plan is set up as a declining balance. The funds will be accessible by using your student card.
- If a student has the \$950.00 meal plan the amount that is needed to spend every day to exhaust funds is \$9.31 daily.
- If a student has the \$1100.00 meal plan the amount that is needed to spend every day to exhaust funds is \$10.78 daily.
- The money on the meal plan is not meant to be the only source of food it is a supplement for meal requirements.
- If a student goes home on weekends this allows for more to be spent during the week.
- If the student card is lost or misplaced the student must come to Food Service Office immediately to avoid theft or misuse of meal funds. The card will be canceled, a temporary card issued until the lost card is found or replaced.
- All the money on the account does transfer from semester to semester but you are required to pay at least the \$950.00 Mandatory for your 2nd semester payment regardless to the balance still on your card. Meal plan money is not refunded but can be used if you are returning to the college in the new academic year.
- Should the student require additional funds over and above the mandatory you can go directly to Food Services Office to add more funds or you can pay at the front desk of the residence.
- Any student experiencing difficulty using their meal plan or require any assistance should visit the Food Service Office to make an appointment with the Operations Manager and Executive Chef.
