


Chrome - Allow Pop-ups


By default, Google Chrome blocks pop-ups from automatically showing up on your screen. When a pop-up is blocked, the address bar will be marked Pop-up blocked. You can also decide to allow pop-ups in certain instances.

Turn pop-ups on

- 1. On your computer, open Chrome.
- 2. At the top right, click on the three dots in the top right corner




4. Under 'Privacy and security', click Site settings.

5. Under 'Content' click on Pop-ups and redirects.
