
How to view your Academic Requirements


You are now able to view and track your progress for your program requirements in your PeopleSoft Student Self Service account.

How to view your Academic Requirements through SLC.me

1. Login to **SLC.me** by going to <http://SLC.me>. You will be presented with a login screen. Enter your full SLC email address (remember to add **@student.sl.on.ca**). Click on 'Next'.

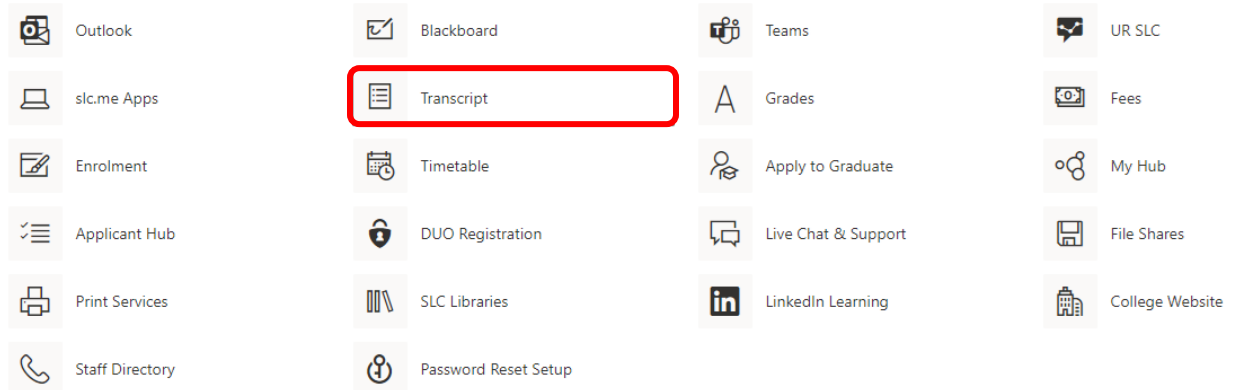


2. Enter your SLC password, and click on 'Sign In'

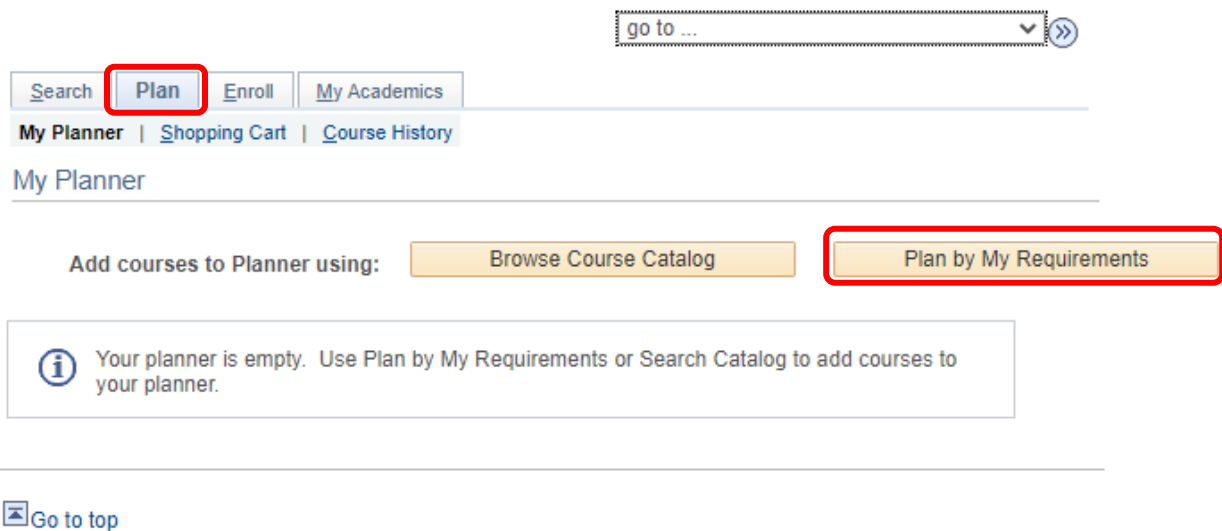

Courses taken and satisfied will be noted with a Green check mark, courses currently enrolled and not graded will display a Yellow diamond, and Planned courses will have a Blue star. You can also see how many courses are remaining, and your current program GPA.
