WIFI – SLCCConnect & SLCPublic

About

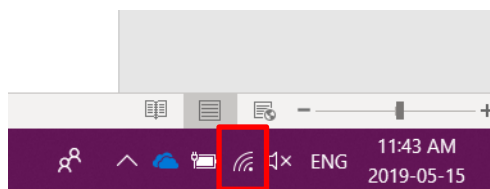
Wireless Internet access is available for personal devices everywhere on campus. At SLC, we have two WIFI networks on campus. The SLCCConnect network is a secure network that you can access with the same credentials that you use to login to slc.me, the college computers, blackboard, etc. The SLCPublic network is available to everyone on campus and requires no password to login.

How to Connect

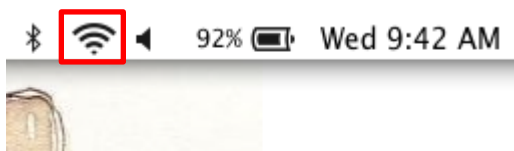
Personal Computer/Laptop

To connect your personal computer/laptop you must **select a wireless network** that your device can connect to. Click on the **connection/Wi-Fi icon** to view available network options.

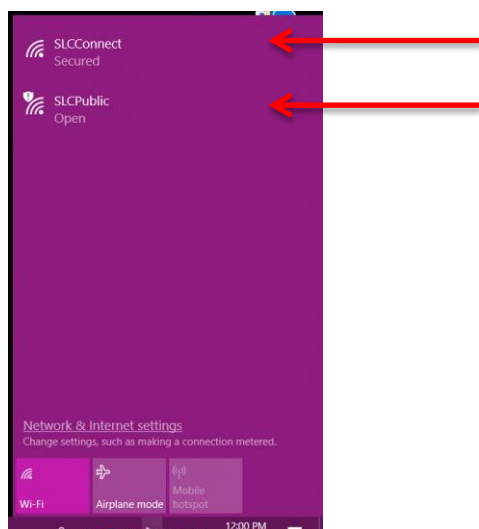

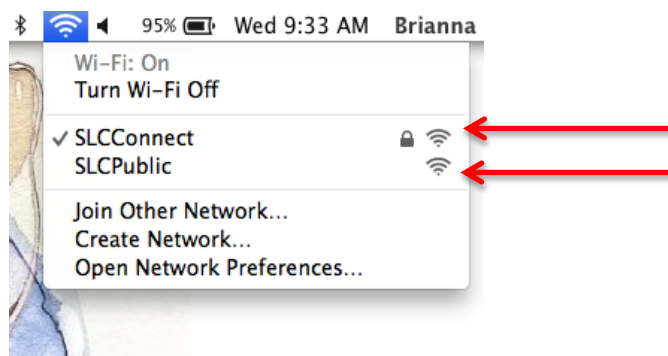


A list of available networks will pop up. **Choose the network** you would like to connect to and follow the next steps to properly connect to the *SLCCConnect* or *SLCPublic* network.

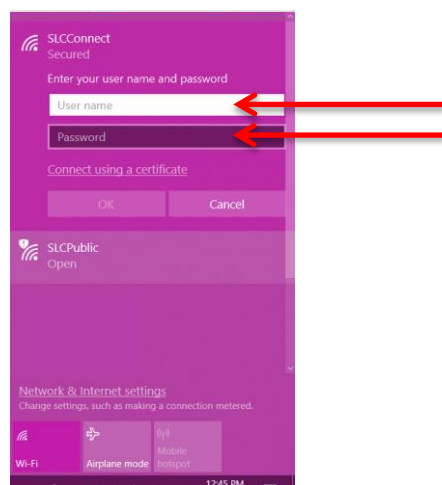

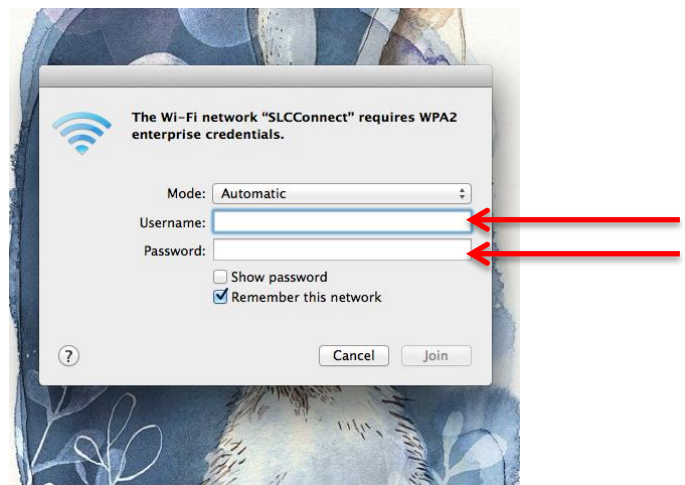
WIFI – SLCCConnect & SLCPublic

Connect to SLCCConnect: *SLCCConnect* is the college's secure network that requires an SLC account to sign in. If you select this network, you will be presented with the screen below and asked to enter a **username** and **password**. You will use the same username and password to sign in that you use to sign in to slc.me, college computers, blackboard, etc. Click **Ok** or **Join** to connect.

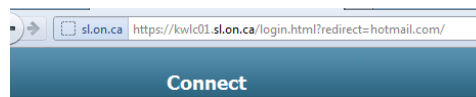

Connect to SLCPublic: *SLCPublic* is the college's open network that anyone on the college campus can connect to. It does not require a username or password to log in and allows all students and visitors of the college to have an available network to connect to without an account. To connect to *SLCPublic* you will need to **accept the web agreement** that opens in your web browser after you select the network.

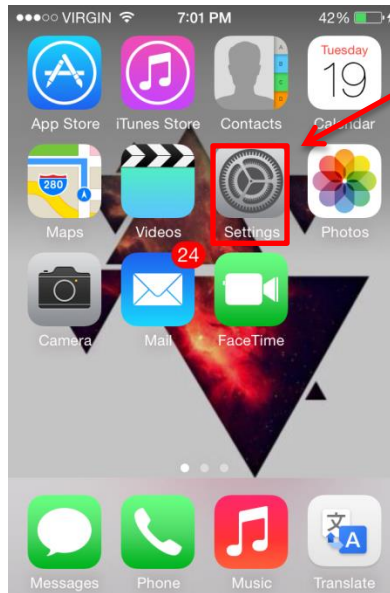

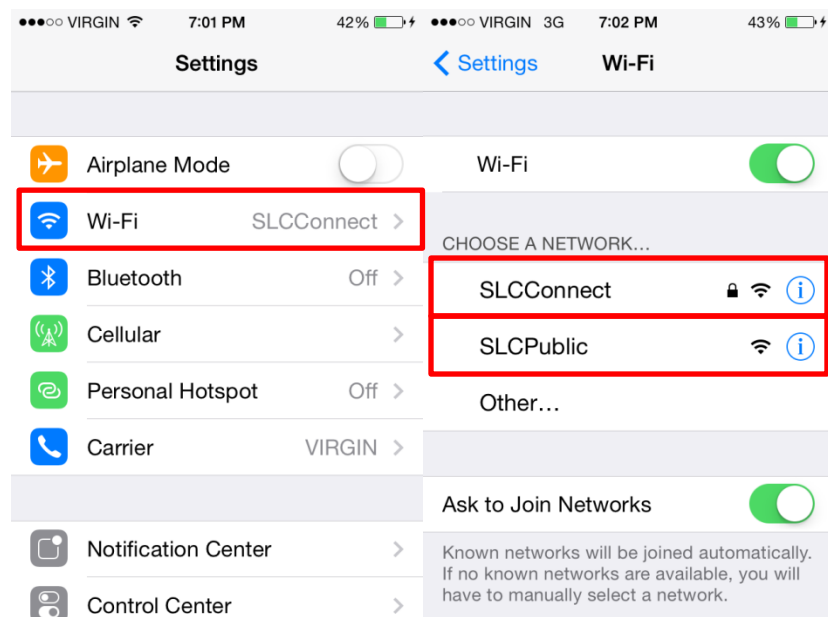
Phone/Tablet

To connect your phone or tablet to *SLConnect* or *SLCPublic*, please follow the steps below:

Choose **Settings**.



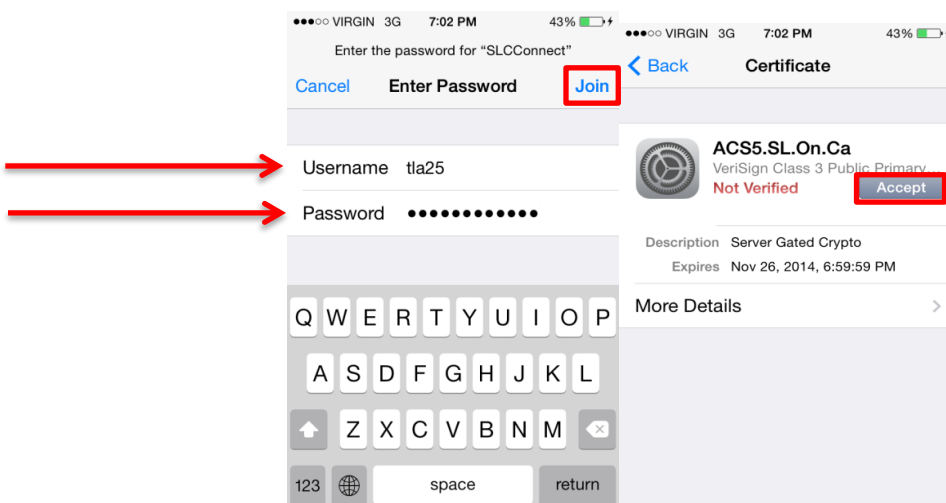
From your **Settings**, select **Wi-Fi** and then select the college network you want to connect to (**SLConnect** or **SLCPublic**).



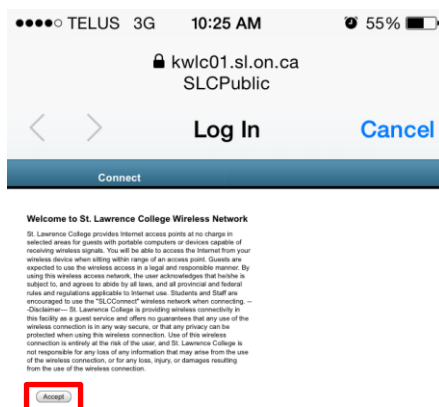
WIFI – SLConnect & SLCPublic

If you select **SLConnect** (*SLC's Secure Network*) you will be required to sign into the network with your SLC login credentials. Enter a **Username or Identity** and **password**. You will use the same username and password to sign in that you use to sign in to slc.me, college computers, blackboard, etc. Click **Join** to connect.

If using an iPhone you will then have to **agree to a certificate agreement** with SLC by clicking **Accept**.



If you select **SLCPublic** (*SLC's Open Network*) follow the same steps up until the login screen. You will not be required to enter a username or password, but you will have to **Agree** to the **mobile web agreement** in your internet browser.
