

About


There are times that your instructor will want you to write an exam without being able to access any other documents/websites from your computer. If this is the case, they will likely ask you to download and install the Respondus Lockdown Browser. Respondus Lockdown Browser is a product designed to assist in preventing cheating during on-campus and/or online exams.

Downloading and Installing the Respondus Lockdown Browser

1. From your computer, Go to <http://slc.me>. We suggest you use 'Google Chrome' for the best experience. You will be presented with a login screen. Enter your full SLC email address (remember to add @student.sl.on.ca). Click on 'Next'.




2. Enter your SLC password, and click on 'Next'



3. From the SLC.me homepage, scroll down, and click on the 'slc.me Apps' icon




3. 'Search' for the Respondus Lockdown Browser app






- It will download an executable file in the corner of the window, as well as putting a copy of the application into your Download folder.

10. Now you will be able to open the Start Menu to see the Respondus Application




11. Double-click on 'LockDown Browser 2 Lab' in order to Launch Respondus


12. This will cause SLC's Blackboard site to automatically open

13. After a couple of minutes, of the Respondus application loading and signing you into your SLC credentials, you will be presented with a Duo Security screen. At this screen, you will be presented with the options to receive a 'Duo Push notification'. 14. This will then log you into Blackboard, and open to a view of your dashboard.

15. Once you're in Blackboard, you will need to choose your Course from the 'My Courses' section as usual.
16. Your exam/quiz will open, and you will only be able to access the software and tools that your instructor has allowed in the set-up of the exam.
17. You will not be able to reach any external sites during the exam unless your instructor has permitted it.
18. You will only be able to utilize certain tools ie. calculator, or special applications if your instructor has permitted it.
19. You will only have access to the test for the duration of time that your instructor has indicated.
20. When you are finished your test, click on 'Submit'
21. You can close out of Respondus, and your computer will now return to its former state, and you will be able to access any software or tools that you could before.
22. You can now go back into Bb into the 'My Grades' tab, and there will be a note that your quiz now needs grading. You will know that your quiz was received properly.
