These services include, ambulatory health care, health promotion, prevention of diseases and injuries, mental health support, immunization and support services. Responsibilities may include but are not limited to:

- Providing clinical assessment, administration and dispensation of medication, diagnostic procedures, client education, treatment/care planning, and referral for further medical attention
- Initiating and managing the care of patients with a disease or disorder within his/her scope of practice and/or monitoring the ongoing therapy of patients
- In collaboration with our Counselling team, providing effective pharmacological and other interventions supporting mental health needs, and counselling of students in crisis, referring and following up to ensure effectiveness of the intervention
- Implementing strategies to promote health and prevent illness with individuals
- Offering confidential counselling for prevention of illness, contraception, nutrition, mental health issues, exercise programs, hypertension, communicable diseases, and other health needs as required.
- Providing, interpreting and planning for immunization and screening requirements, health and wellness issues, and laboratory results in relation to symptoms present or immunization requirements
- Practicing as a member of an interprofessional team and providing consultation to support the overall health care needs of our students.
