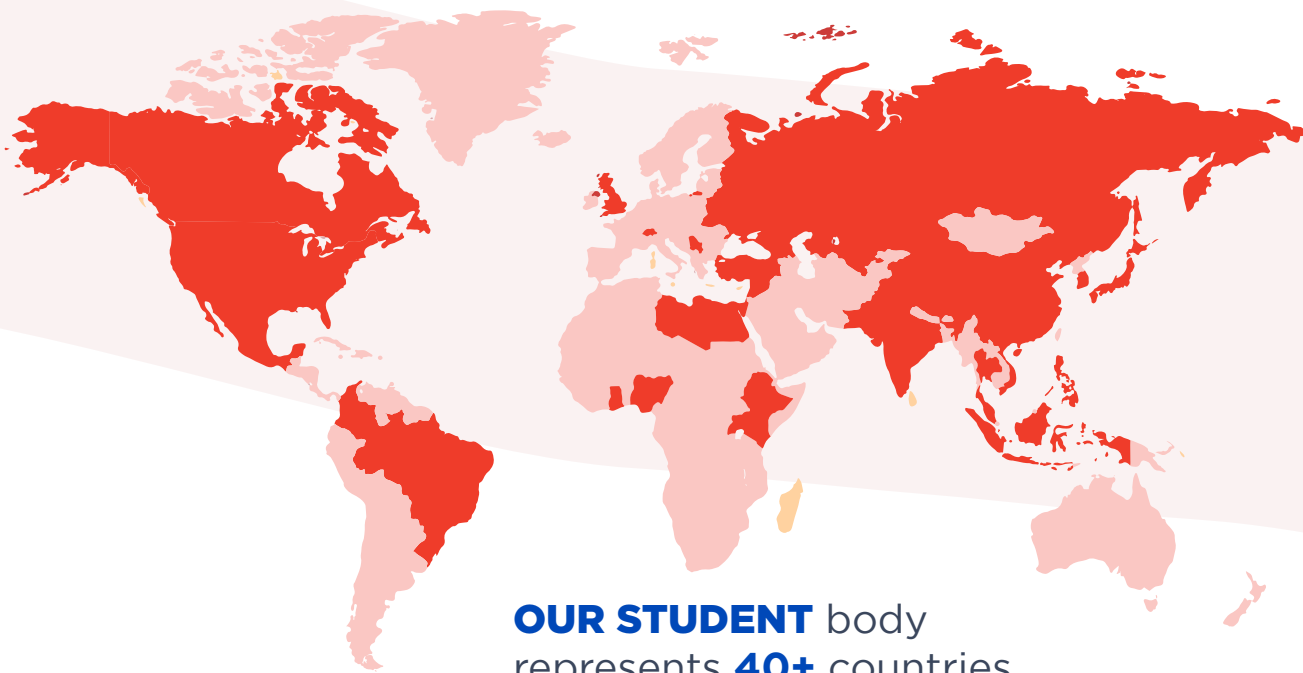

Studying in a Changing, Intercultural College

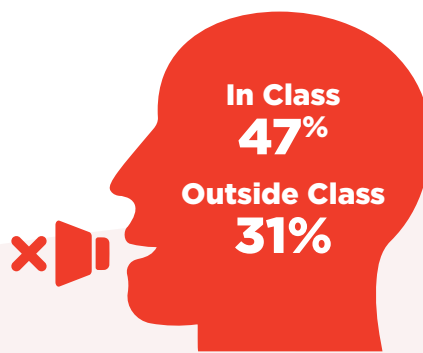
Internationalization of education aims to increase openness, understanding of other worldviews.



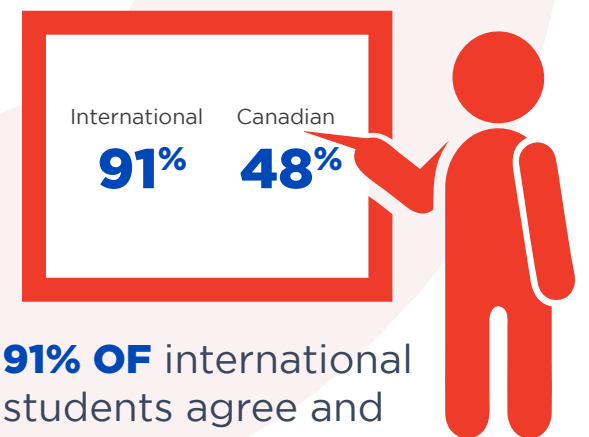
OF STUDENTS surveyed believe that **intercultural skills** are **valuable**.



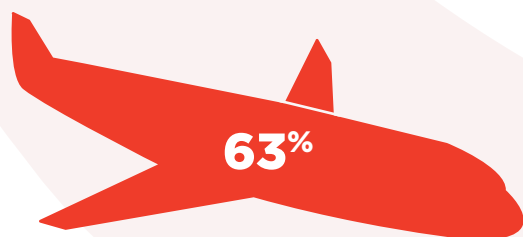
OF STUDENTS surveyed, **62%** agreed that SLC and our campus communities are **culturally inclusive environments** while in comparison, only **42%** of employees agreed.



INTERCULTURAL engagement remains **low**: **47%** of student respondents **interact** with students from **cultures other than their own** inside of class and only **31%** outside of class.



91% OF international students agree and **48%** of Canadian students agree that SLC should **include more intercultural dimensions** in its **course content**.



OF STUDENTS are interested in **international exchange opportunities**, citing affordability as the top barrier to pursuing.
