The theme of the Marianne van Silfhout Gallery's 2025 Alumni Juried Exhibition is '**Proof of Life**'. We invite those who turn to creative practice not just as expression, but as affirmation, to submit their work that reflects on WHY YOU CREATE. All interpretations of the theme will be considered.

This juried exhibition is open to **all** previous SLC students from **an**y program, certificate, or course across our three campuses, including Continuing Education and 1000 Islands Summer School of the Arts.

We welcome submissions in a **wide variety** of mediums, including but not limited to video, sound, painting, drawing, photography, printmaking, pottery, woodworking, jewelry, sculpture, written texts, and textiles.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: SATURDAY, June 7, 2025, AT NOON.

GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY:

- Works must be original and created without the aid of an instructor.
- There is no date restriction on the year created.
- Artwork is permitted to have been previously exhibited in the gallery.
- All mediums are accepted and must be ready for display:
 - sculpture must be sturdy or supported
 - paintings and photographs must be appropriately framed or wired for hanging on gallery hooks (the gallery does not use nails or screws)
- Work must be clearly labeled on the back or bottom with artist's name & title of work.

*The Marianne van Silfhout Gallery does not charge commission on works sold during exhibitions. All sales will be directed to the artist to secure.

AWARDS: Awards totaling \$1000 will be presented to artists at the reception.

ENTRY FEE: \$35.00 flat rate - maximum of 3 entries per person (non-refundable entry fee). Payments accepted by cash or cheque. **Please make cheques payable to: St. Lawrence College.**
