

### E-rase your E-waste!

Electronic waste, also called e-waste, are various forms of electric and electronic equipment that are outdated and unwanted.

E-waste is categorized into two groups, "white goods" such as refrigerators, washing machines, and microwaves and "brown goods" such as televisions, radios, computers, and cell phones. Given that the information and technology revolution has exponentially increased the use of new electronic equipment, it has also produced growing volumes of obsolete products; e-waste is one of the fastest-growing waste streams.

#### SLC Tackles E-Waste!

We have partnered with the Ontario Electronic Stewardship (OES) to have permanent e-waste drop-off bins at all three campuses in Kingston, Brockville, and Cornwall so SLC diverts all hazardous e-waste from entering landfills.

#### E-Waste We Accept!

TV's, monitors, non-cellular phones, personal desktop computers, personal laptops, computer peripherals, desktop printers, personal/portable audio systems, home audio/video systems, home theatre systems, floor standing photocopiers, vehicle audio/video systems, and cellular devices.

#### Why is E-Waste a Problem?

When electronics end up in landfills, toxics like lead, mercury, and cadmium leach into the soil and water.

The electronic waste problem is huge: More than 20 million tons of e-waste are produced every year (iFixit.org, 2018).

#### Our Partners- Ontario Electronic Stewardship (OES)

The Ontario Electronic Stewardship – an industry-led, not-for-profit organization that operates the regulated recycling program in Ontario. They ensure that end-of-life electronics are handled in a safe, secure and environmentally-sound manner.
