

A Sustainable Future with SLC

The college is a member of the globally recognized Association for the Advancement of Sustainability for Higher Education (AASHE) and is employing the Sustainability Rating and Tracking System (STARS) to guide target setting and metrics for progress.

An initial gap analysis has been conducted to determine what has been done and what opportunities there are to move further along the Sustainability continuum.

A tri-campus energy compilation has also been completed to allow a comparison of greenhouse gas emissions, energy consumption and energy costs compared to a baseline year.
