Show the following design-related work (visual responses) and statement-of-intent (written response). Depending on the individual it may require approximately eight hours for its proper completion.

Visual Responses

Please submit high-quality photographs or scans, in .jpg format, of 5-10 pieces of your own ORIGINAL creative work from any of the following categories:

- Graphic Design projects: logos/posters/advertising/websites
- Multimedia projects: videos/photography/motion graphics
- Art-based projects: drawings/paintings, etc.

Written Response

In a Word document or PDF of 300-500 words, please answer the following, in paragraph form.

Research and consider current trends in visual culture and the graphic design industry. What do you think a designer’s role and impact on society will be in the next five years? How does this fit in with your personal and career goals?
